



POLICY FOR THE ACCEPTABLE USE OF EMAIL, TEAMS AND THE INTERNET

Devices are provided for educational use. Students are expected to complete any work set and the Principal may ask for the device to be returned if work is not completed.

Parents must supervise their child's access to the device and ensure it is used appropriately. Internet usage is monitored and this information may be shared with the Principal.

Devices must be returned when requested by school.

E-Mail and Teams Guidelines

- Students should check their Class Team regularly
- Students may post to their Class Team to ask their questions or to make comments about school work.
- Messages posted online should be polite and respectful.
- Teachers may send posts to their Class Teams to give reminders, set assignments, give reminders and ask questions.
- Teachers are not expected to reply to messages on Class Teams outside of the school day.
